Qualitative Data
Collection**

Problem formulation	
Design an appropriate sampling plan or strategy	
Adapt regional questionnaires and research tools	
Plan for data collection, including study personnel, equipment (tape recorders), transport, accommodation, finance, logistics	
Plan for data analysis, including how will you get interviews transcribed and translated, who will analyse the data, do you need technical assistance for analysis?	
Translate materials and questionnaires	
Pre-test materials and revise	
Write a preliminary national study protocol	
Organization and fieldwork	
Obtain consent from the participating communities	
Obtain consent from other local, district, or national authorities concerned	
Obtain ethical clearance from ethical review committee	
Recruit interviewers	
Train interviewers with regional support	
Plan for supervision of interviewers	
Conduct interviews	
Analysis and report	
Transcribe interviews	
Translate interviews into English where necessary	
Case study analysis	
Thematic coding	
Perform preliminary analysis, discuss with the research team and community representatives and various relevant parties	
Complete final analysis and interpretation	
Report and disseminate findings	
Plan for interventions and evaluation
